West Coast Gymnastics produces state champions

The West Coast Olympic Gymnastics Academy had two champions at the men's Junior Olympic state championship held last weekend.

Chris Turner won the Level 10 all-around state title after winning parallel bars, rings, high bar and vault.

Christopher Siebel took the all-around Level 8 state title after winning parallel bars. Siebel was second on rings and floor and finished third on pommel horse.

The WCOGA Level 10 team won the team race.

John Monteclaro from came in third place all-around after earning a third on pommel horse and parallel bars. Ethan Jose was fourth all-around after earning a second on rings and third on high bar. Alex Ganz was sixth overall and second on parallel. Mark Ringle was also sixth overall with a third on rings and high bar.

The Level 9 team was outstanding in finishing second. Justin Woo and Jonathon Liu both tied for third all-around. Woo was first on pommel and second on rings and bars. Liu was second on floor and third on high bar. Travis Gollott was eighth overall.

Nick Canaparo placed fifth all-around for Level 8 at the Northern California state championships. Canaparo was fifth on the high bar and rings. Patrick Corona was fifth on the parallel bars and sixth on the pommel horse.

At Level 10, Brandon Jessup, 14-15, was fourth on floor and eighth all-around.
